We provide peer support services, northern NV resource guidance and referrals, workforce development, computer skills training, individual and group advocacy, family support through CRAFT meetings, we host 12-step and other mutual aid meetings every day of the week. We also have a food pantry for peers in need, clothing closet, basic hygiene needs, etc. We do community outreach, including to the many transient encampments. We provide overdose awareness and prevention training to the community and provide free NARCAN kits. FFR also provides many training classes, including being one of only two entities in NV that can provide PSS certification training. Our Sparks center offers it 2-3 times per year. Assistance with finding housing support, basic higher education financial aid guidance, referrals to community partners for services too numerous to list them all, but include emergency assistance, specialized CJ and reintegration for those coming out of incarceration, pro bono legal resources, housing, etc. I am currently awaiting approval for myself and a female CPRSS to gain clearance to the county jail, so we can provide PSS services there, as well.
